NEIQG Board Minutes April 27, 2021

The board met on April 27, 2021, via Zoom at 7:00 pm. Meeting began at 7:07. Agenda was reviewed. Board members in attendance: Lori Heitman, Marge Johnson, Carol Maki, Bert Hass, Martha Bartenhagen, Leslie Sand, Arlene Klatt, Marty Berda, Nancy Sojka, Jen Hertrampf, Ila Benzing, and Mike Ellingsen.

Minutes from our last board meeting (3-9-2021) were printed in the newsletter. Leslie reported to the board a balance of \$5,171.60. We bought the trailer license and title transfer.

Old Business :Articles of Incorporation/Certificate of Existence: Melodye was not in attendance so item was tabled.

Election Committee report: The committee did not publish a complete list of the ballot in the newsletter: Carol Maki for Historian, Marge Johnson for Newsletter Editor. Discussion on what to do. It was decided that a reminder email would be sent to the membership so they would know the full ballot for voting.

The Annual Meeting will be held in person at 6:00 pm (notice time change) in the Waukon City Park Shelter and on Facebook/Zoom on Tuesday, June 1st. Members that attend in person are encouraged to bring their own sack lunch, sit physically distant, and wear masks. We will hold elections, pay membership dues, bring your row by row challenges to be voted on, and win door prizes. Melody will reserve the shelter. Membership will pray for good weather.

Summer Mini-Quilt Events: Bert has a poster on the mini quilts shows, discussed getting signs from Budweiser, will have membership forms and volunteers are needed. Bring your quilts to Living Faith Parish United Methodist Church, 702 South Main Street, Monona on Thursday, June 10th, from 3-6, and Friday, June 11th from 9-11. "Welcome to the Airing Out the Quilts" in Monona during Hay Days Saturday, June 12th, 1-6.

There will be a paper over the quilt draped on the pews to identify the quilter. People can show the same quilts at all the mini shows. We need volunteers to bring quilts if people can't get to Monona. Bert said that the Hay Day Parade is a Garden Theme if we want to do a float entry. Grandmother's flower garden quilts were suggested for a float idea. Lori wants to have at least 3 churches in her area to host the mini quilt shows on July 10th. She is looking for hosts to be at the churches in the Eitzen and New Albin area. Marty is planning a mini quilt show at the Methodist Church in Elgin in September. Decorah could do an outdoor show in August.

New Business : Lori is selling the old trailer.

Budget- Lori feels we need to do a budget and look at it at the June meeting. Leslie will draft a budget and email it to board members. The board will discuss it after the annual meeting.

Program Co-chairs- Mike is helping Nancy, but he needs someone to help him next year.

Program Updates- Bert, Nancy and Mike- Mike Ellingsen will present in May on the Color of the Year; there is no program in June: we will show our Row by Rows. July: we have 4 County Fairs in our area so will ask quilt chairs to discuss their procedures and judging ideas; A brochure will be available to new members. We have 4 tickets from the Winterset Quilt museum. It was proposed that we may Zoom on January & February meetings. The Winterset Quilt museum archives their Tuesday's shows, so you may watch those on line.

May 1st at Arlene's in Fayette- The transferring of the trailer contents; Meet at 9:30 to work, wash the contents, and put in the new trailer.

The newsletter deadline is May 15th.

Next Board Meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, June 1st, 2021 after the guild meeting via Zoom and in person.

Mike made a motion to adjourn, Marty seconded; motion passed. Meeting ended at 8:18 pm.

They can also be brought to the June 1 meeting or to the homes of Marge Johnson in Elkader, Marty Berda in Elgin area, Carol Maki in Decorah, and Lori Heitman in Waukon area. Please firmly attach a label to your quilts. The quilts will be draped on the pew backs with a paper tent label next to each quilt. The church ladies will be serving light refreshments during the show and we will have quilt related items for sale that day. Admission and sale will be free will. Unsold quilt related items will go to the next drive-by show.
