

SHADY CHARACTER CHALLENGE

A quilt challenge to demonstrate your skill with tints, tones, and shades - there are only nice shady characters in the NEIQG!



- 1. Choose any color that you enjoy red, blue, green, gray, pink any single color.
- 2. You can use any version of that color for example, if you chose blue, you can use everything from the lightest sky blue (but not white) to the darkest navy (but not black) contrast is the key. Note if you want to use black and white, you should choose gray as your color!
- 3. Patterned fabrics are just fine but can only include variations of your color no blue swirls with yellow dots!
- 4. Choose a pattern from your list of "I want to make this quilt some day" or just start cutting and sewing to make it up as you go along.
- 5. Make your project by any method piecing, appliqué, fusing, whole cloth, collage... Make your project in any size from postcard to king sized quilt.
- 6. When you've finished the top, quilt and finish it.
- 7. Bring your completed project to the May 2024 annual meeting for show-and-tell and then save it for display in the October 2024 quilt show.
