2026 Quilt Show Update

Summarized June 2, 2025

The members of the Northeast Iowa Quilters Guild, in preparation for the 2026 Quilt Show, were surveyed to gather information regarding member interest about the raffle quilt designs/colors and participation on the team. Info was gathered through an on-line survey and a survey of sample quilt pictures at the Annual Meeting in May. A group of guild members who volunteered to serve on the Quilt Committee include: co-chairs Sue Schulz and Bert Hass, Ila Benzing, Sue Lynch, Marie Freerking, Arlene Klatt, Candace Arp, Marge Johnson, Lynette Rose and Jennifer Hertrampf. We welcome any additional guild members who would like to participate on this decision-making body, and if someone who expressed an interest was overlooked, our apologies. It was not intentional. Guild members will have ample opportunities to participate in the various activities needed for the Quilt Show as well as making the raffle quilt.

An initial meeting was held May 19 th . Raffle Quilt criteria feedback considered as important included a desire to focus on traditional quilt block designs, a controlled color palette, fewer HSTs, use of Stripology rulers to ensure accurate piece cuts and a possible station type process where different participants could choose to focus on a task they felt more comfortable with (e.g. ironing, cutting, pinning, piecing, assembly) while enjoying the fellowship of working with others for our initial meetings.

Once a final pattern is determined, there will be more about this forthcoming. A possible pattern has been selected and the author has been contacted for permission to use it. We are awaiting his decision. If that option doesn't work out, the team will pursue another similar pattern focusing on either a star or log cabin feature, or a quilt that combines these traditional blocks. The initial color palette selected are shades of blues; with a second option of forest colors (greens and browns). We would like to get started this summer, so you will see some options forthcoming during future guild meetings.

The Northeast Iowa Quilters' Guild held an in person and Zoom gathering on April 1st, 2025 at 2:00 pm at First United Methodist Church, Decorah (302 W. Broadway) with approximately 20 people in attendance and approximately 4 attending via Zoom. Quilt guild member Nancy Sojka displayed her various vintage creations and discussed the decisions and examples that she used for her wall-hangings. Show and Tell was held and pictures posted on Facebook.

Nancy Sojka held a workshop after the 2:00 guild meeting; members brought their own collections of vintage handkerchiefs and family textiles and Nancy helped suggest arrangements and designs using

the various materials. By 5:00 pm, the weather deteriorated and the attendance consensus was to cancel the evening meeting, so all could return to their homes safely. Arlene Klatt put a notice on Facebook to let the membership know of the meeting cancellation.

Next Guild Meeting: Our Annual meeting is: May 6th , 2025. Annual Potluck Meeting - only one guild meeting that day and the meal will start at 6:00 pm. The guild business/Annual meeting will begin at 7:00 pm at First United Methodist Church, Decorah (302 W. Broadway). There is a lift at the Broadway Street door of the Methodist Church that will take members who do not want to use stairs to the basement. Hold the button to open the lift door. Once inside the lift, hold the button inside the lift until you are at the basement level. The church door on Court Street has a stairway that goes directly into Fellowship Hall. The double door on Court Street goes directly down to the basement.

desserts, last names of R-S please provide salads. The board members will provide the beverages. Candace Arp said that we can use the plates, glasses, and silverware at the church, so you do not need to bring your own.
